Harvest by hand in boxes. Fermentation in barrels aged 1 to 4 years.

Tasting Notes

Colour: Dark ruby

Nose: Red fruits, spicy

Taste: An indulgent wine with a strong personality. It is a fresh lengthy wine with hints of black fruits, garrigue, vanilla, chocolate, moka and pepper.

Terroir

Clay-limestone soil at the foot of the Alpilles

Vinification

Harvest by hand in boxes. Destemming then maceration with gentle extraction for 3 weeks. Aging in oak barrels and in vats.
